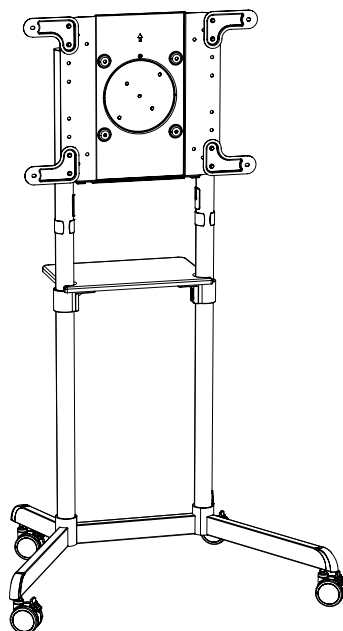
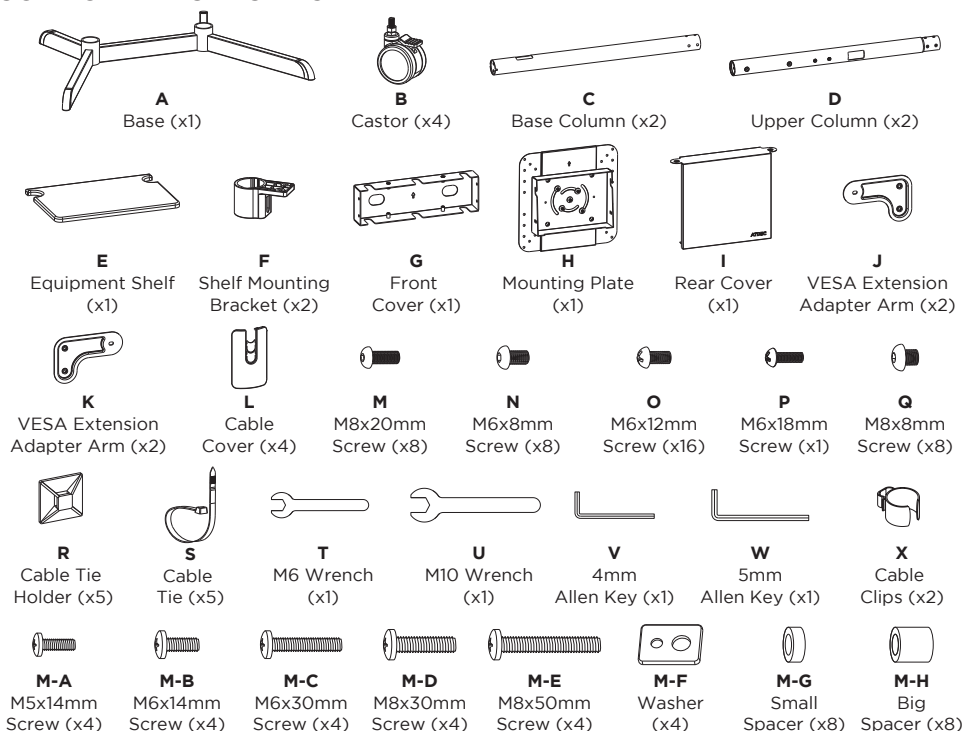

1. Install the Castors

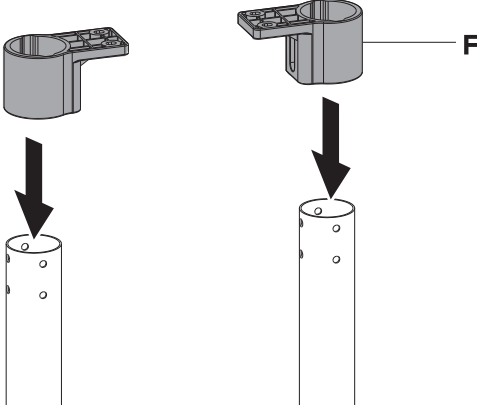
	Lock the brakes on the castors to avoid any sudden movements during installation.

2. Attach the columns to the base

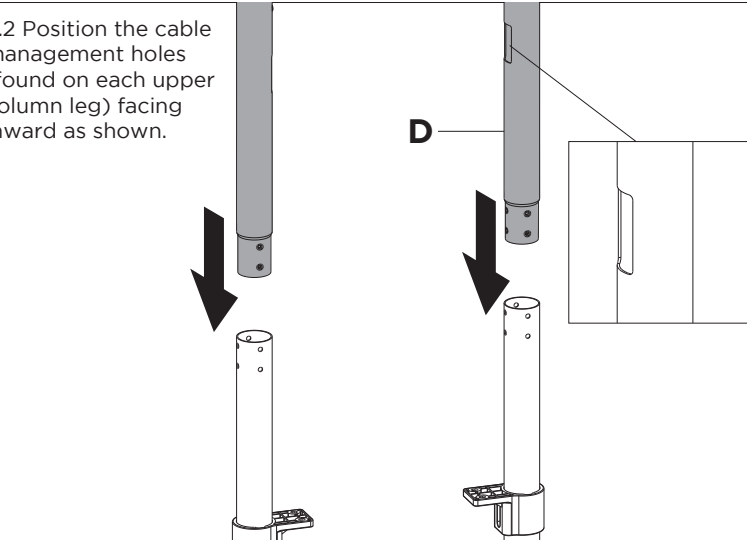
Align the column as shown, making sure that the cable management holes and the shorter legs are on the same side.	
	Do not fully tighten the screws M.

3. Connect the columns

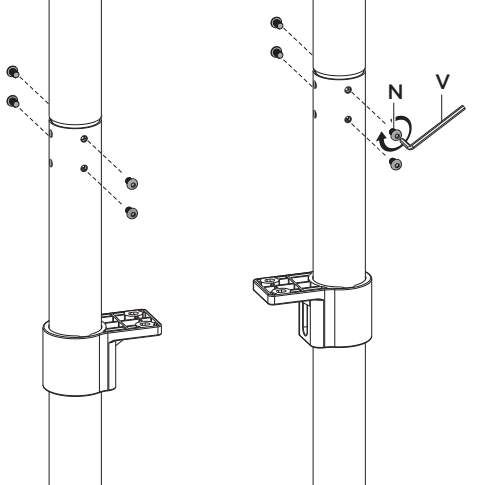
3.1 Slide shelf mounting brackets over the lower columns prior to connecting the upper column.



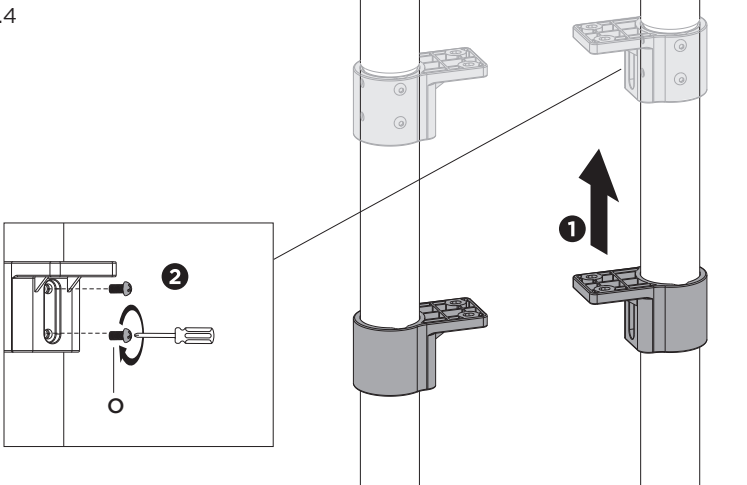
3.2 Position the cable management holes (found on each upper column leg) facing inward as shown.

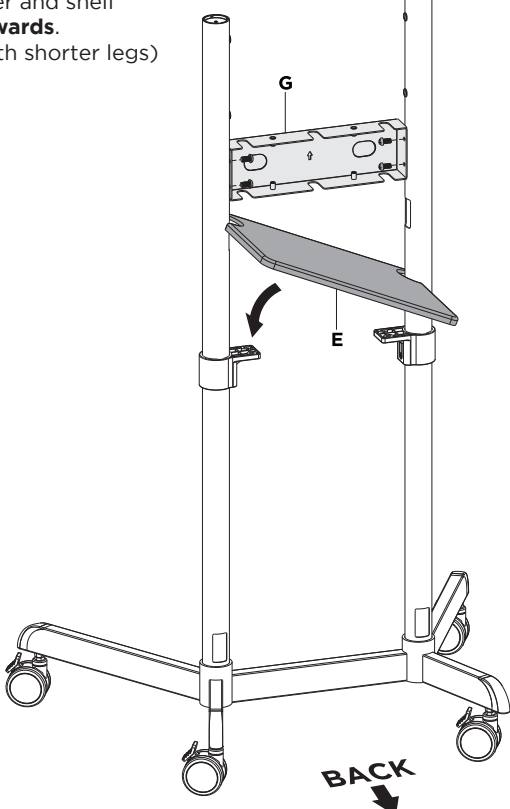

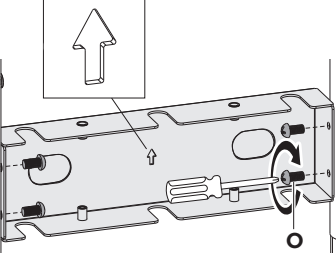


4. Install the front cover and equipment shelf

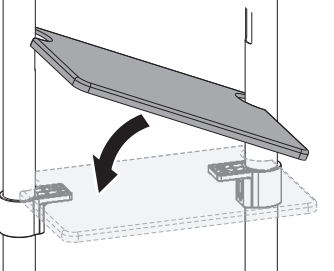
Position both open side of front cover and shelf facing **backwards**.
(The side with shorter legs)



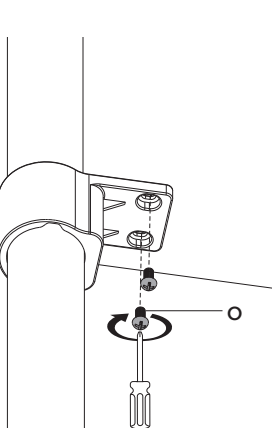

5 . Attach the mounting plate to display

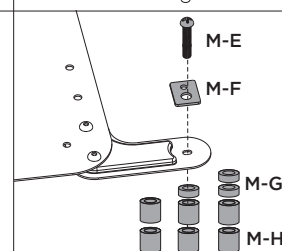
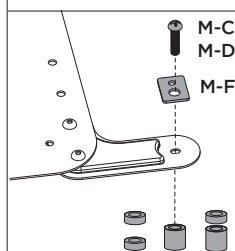
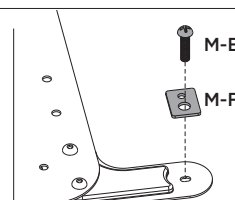
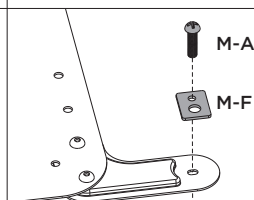
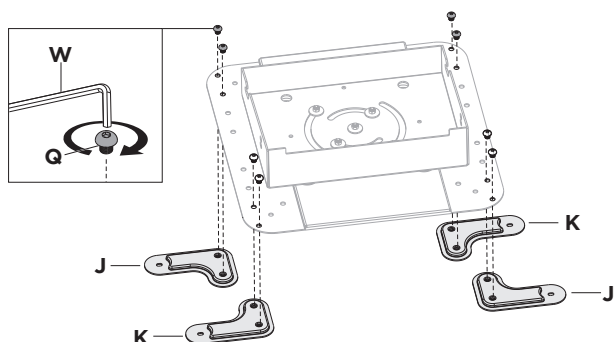
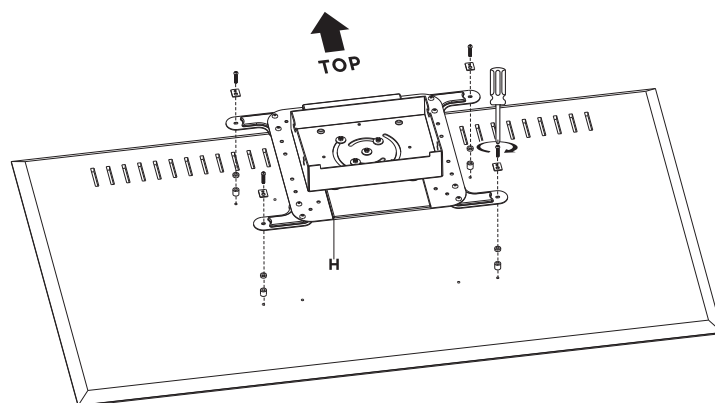
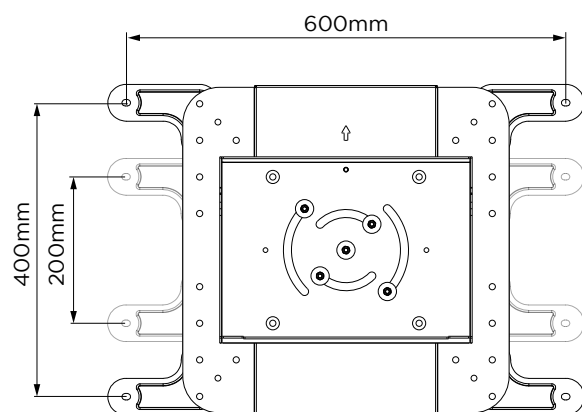
- Select screws to suit display
- Use small or large hole in washer to suit screw
- Use spacers if required to compensate for long fasteners, or recessed/uneven monitor surfaces
- Use the smallest number of spacers that will work



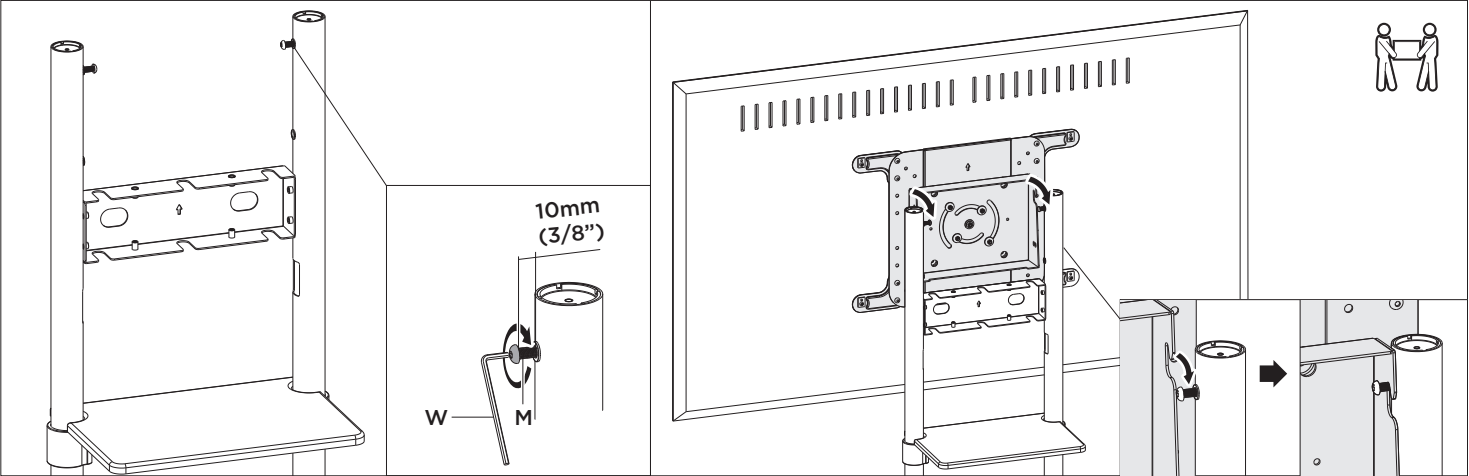

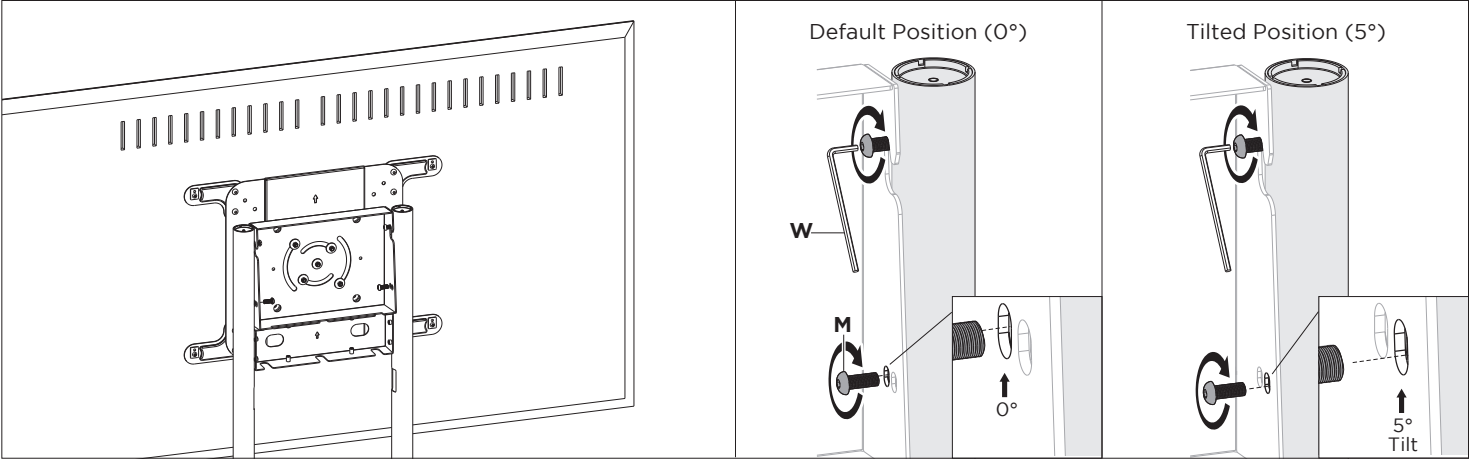

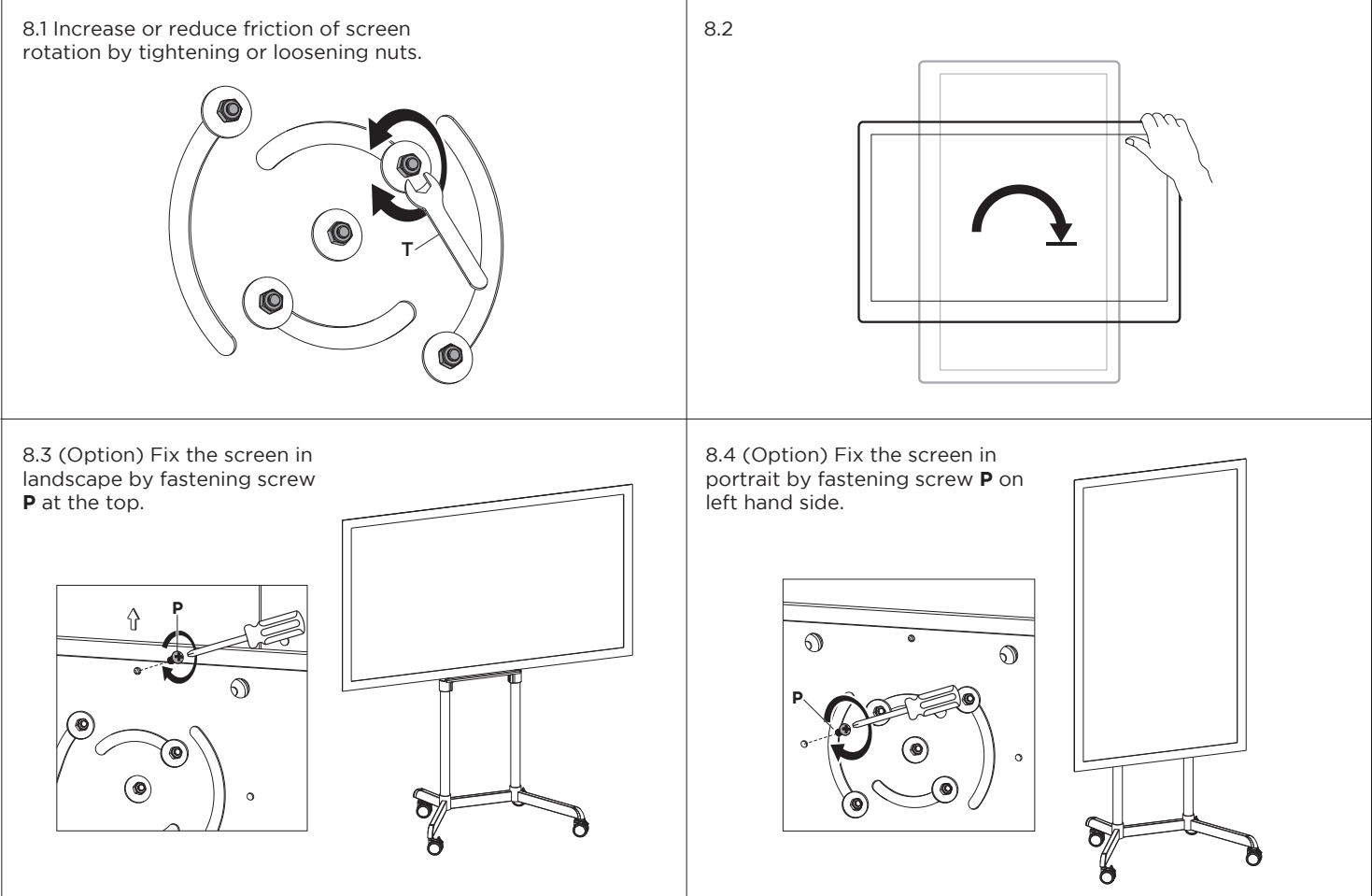
6. Mount display onto screws



7. Set the tilt angle of the display



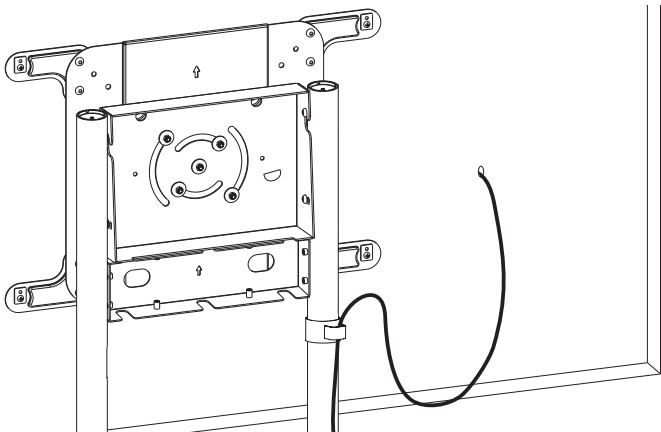
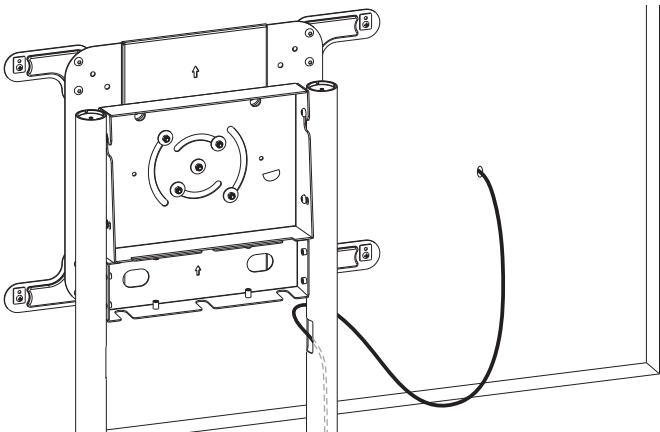

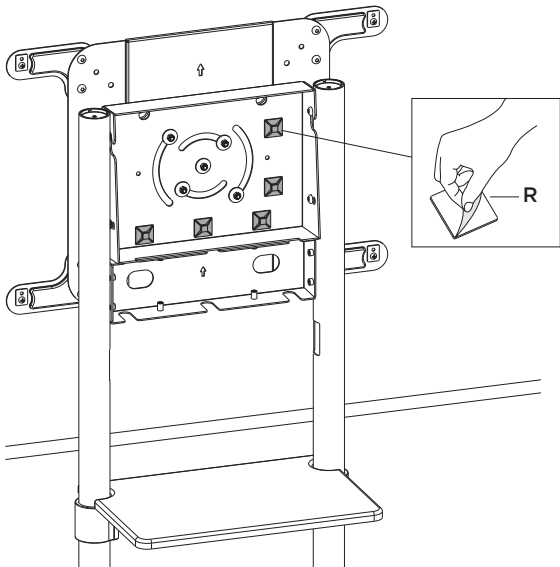
9. Cable routing options

9.1 Cables can be routed down the inside or outside of column.

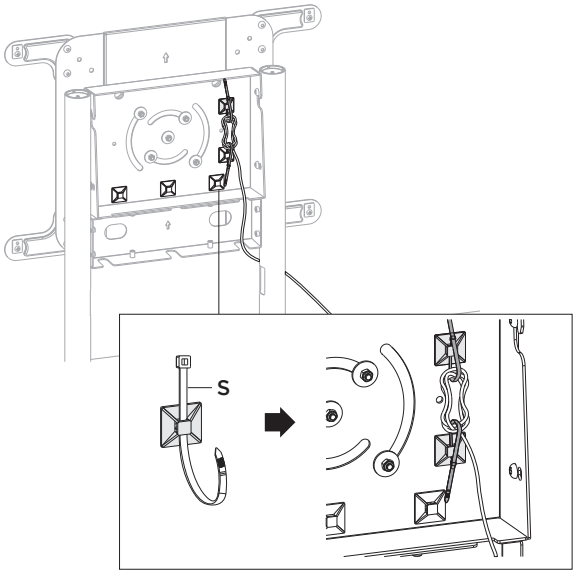
 CAUTION: Allow sufficient loop in cables for screen rotation.



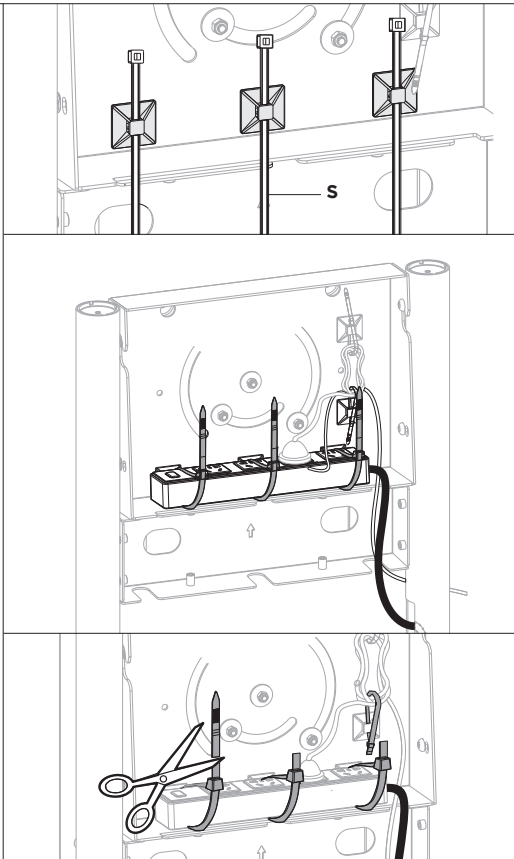
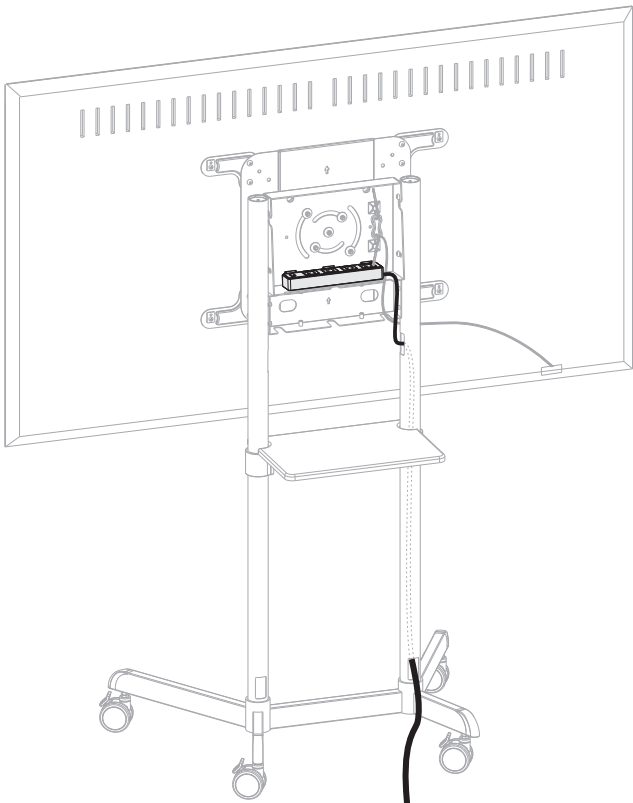

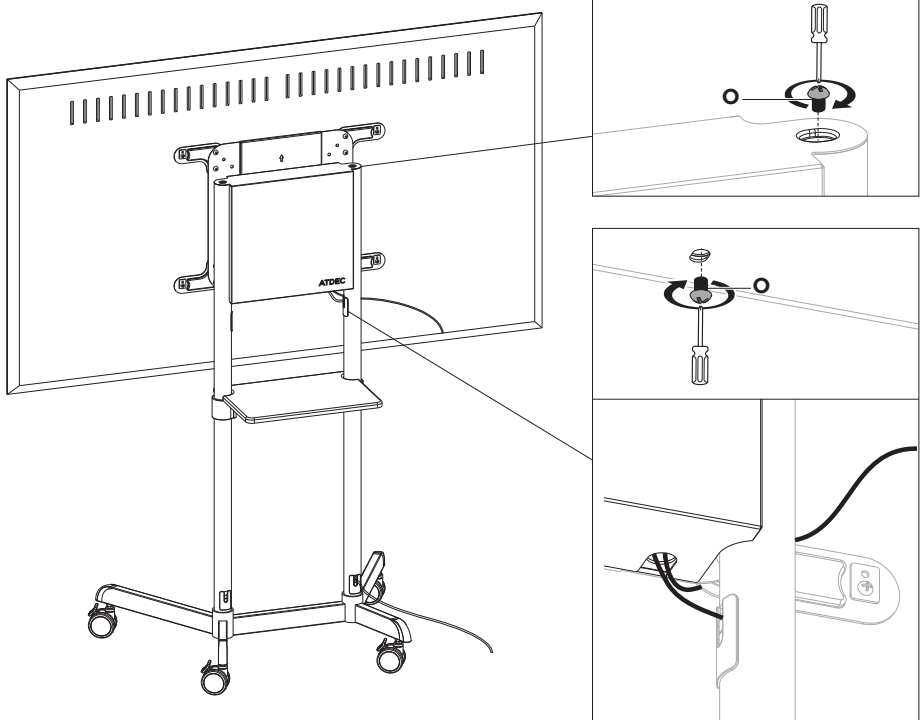
10. Attach cable covers
